This tournament has generated more than \$225,000 for scholarships since its inception.

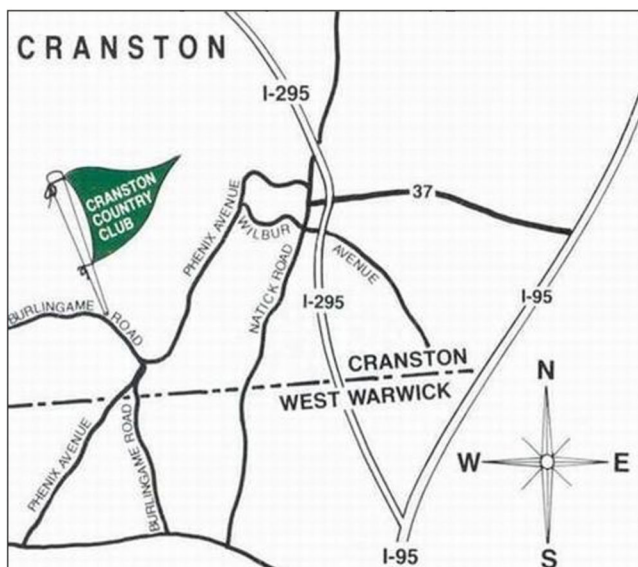
